T1.1 TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

uMngeni-uThukela Water is a state owned business enterprise that operates within the South African legislative parameters. The primary function of uMngeni-uThukela Water is to supply treated water in bulk to its municipal customers.

Competent and experienced Service Providers are invited to Tender for the following:

Appointment of a Professional Service Provider to Develop a Routine Optimisation System in Order to Minimise the Sampling Services Fleet Distances and Reduce uMngeni-uThukela Water's Direct Carbon Emission for 12 Months

In addition to the Eligibility Criteria specified in Clause F2.1 of the tender document, tenderers are required to fulfil the following:

- (1) The tenderer shall Provide a Valid accreditation certificate (showing entity used to tender being certified) issued by an accredited certifier [e.g International Organization for Standardization (ISO)] (ISO 14001,9001,14002) or Equavalent certification issued by an accreditation body.
- (2) The proposed key personnel must have the following professional registration
- (a) The Project Manager must be registered as a Professional Project Manager (Pr.PM) with Project Management South Africa.
- (b) The Geographic Information Systems Specialist must be registered with South African Geomatics Council (SAGC) certificate.
- (c) The Information Technology Specialist (Programming) must be professionalyy registered with Chartered Information Technology Professional (South Africa)/ Information Technology Certified Professional ITCP(SA)

(Submit proof of registration for the above mentioned key personnel)

Evaluation method:

The tender will firstly be evaluated on eligibility. If found to be eligible, it will be further evaluated in two stages i.e.

- Functionality shall be assessed. A minimum functionality score of seventy (70) points is required for the tender to be considered further.
 - Price & Preference Goals using the 80/20Preference Point Scoring System in terms of PPPFA 80/20
- Price and Preference goals
 - 1. In compliance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022, the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system is applicable: points for this bid shall be awarded for:
 - a) Price; and (80) and
 - b) Preference as defined in SBD 6.1 (20)
 - 2. The Preference Goals that have been identified for this bid is stipulated in SBD 6.1
 - 3. Failure on the part of a bidder to submit proof or documentation required in terms of this tender document to claim points for specific goals, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for specific goals are not claimed by the bidder.
